



STANDARD TERMS OF LEAVE TO APPEAR

Pursuant to paragraph 12 of Practice Guideline 1, and subject to any other direction made by the Commissioner, the following standard terms will apply to grants of leave to appear before the Commission:

1. Leave is granted to appear at hearings of the Commission at which evidence will be taken or submissions received relating to issues in which the party granted leave has a substantial and legitimate interest.
2. Participation in such hearings by the cross examination of witnesses, the tender of oral or written evidence, or the presentation of submissions will be subject to the grant of further leave which may be granted on terms which may include, without limitation, the following:
 - a. limitation of the particular topics or issues upon which the party may cross-examine, tender evidence or present submissions;
 - b. the imposition of time or other limitations upon cross-examination, evidence-in-chief or presentation of submissions;
 - c. the provision of prior notice to the Commission of documents or other evidence to be tendered or a written outline of any proposed submissions; or
 - d. the requirement that submissions or evidence be presented in writing only.
